

Issue #4: What page to use to add a new forecast.


Proposed solution:

Bottom menu icons are unclear.


Proposed solution: Place additional words on the bottom of each icon for reinforcement and be clear as to what they represent (what page it will take you to.)





Icon for "My Forecasts" is confusing.






What page should you use to add a forecast?


Proposed solution: Still have the main homepage have a CTA button for adding a forecast

including second way to add through the "Search" page.




What page should you use to add a forecast?


Proposed solution: Search page allows for another way to add a new forecast to your list!
