

Preference test 1


Objective:

Figure out if users prefer a log in page with an image and buttons on the bottom versus a clean and simple log in page with button in the middle of the screen.


Participants & Tools:

Design A



Preference test 2


Objective:






Participants & Tools:

I used Usability Hub to conduct the preference test and had 10 friends, family and acquaintances participate in the test.














Results
